### SUMMARY

The one HIV<sup>1</sup>, AIDS<sup>2</sup>, and STI<sup>3</sup> Information System (OHASIS) was developed by EB-NHSS<sup>4</sup> as a centralized information system for HIV, STIs, and Viral Hepatitis (VH).

The STI module in the OHASIS captures data on the following infections:

1. Syphilis;
2. Gonorrhea and other non-gonococcal infections;
3. Trichomoniasis;
4. Human papillomavirus;
5. Genital warts;
6. Herpes simplex virus (HSV)
7. Bacterial vaginosis.

Meanwhile, the VH module in the OHASIS covers reporting on Hepatitis B and C.

### ACTIONABLE ADVICE:

All health facilities shall utilize both the STI and VH modules in the OHASIS as mandated by the DOH EB-NHSS.
