SUMMARY

The DTI launched the One DTI Portal on 26 March 2026, consolidating key government services into a single digital platform for businesses and consumers. The portal enables users to complete transactions such as business registration, accreditation applications, and consumer complaint filing without navigating multiple systems or duplicating information.

Previously fragmented across various bureau-managed websites, DTI services are now integrated to improve efficiency, accessibility, and user experience. The platform includes services such as business name registration, e-commerce trustmark applications, online dispute resolution, and consumer complaint systems.

This initiative supports the government's broader digitalization agenda and Ease of Doing Business mandate, aligning with the Philippine Development Plan 2023–2028. The portal is expected to enhance transparency, streamline regulatory processes, and improve access to government services for enterprises of all sizes.

ACTIONABLE ADVICE

Covered businesses should transition to the One DTI Portal to streamline registrations, filings, and compliance processes. Companies must ensure that submitted information is accurate and consistent across applications to avoid delays or regulatory issues.
