NEW TESDA INNOVATION HUB TO BOOST JOB-READY SKILLS IN NCR

SUMMARY

The TESDA has begun construction of the Regional Technical And Vocational Education And Training (TVET) Innovation Center–National Capital Region (RTIC-NCR) in Taguig City to expand access to advanced, industry-driven training. The facility will offer programs in high-demand fields such as automation, mechatronics, and smart technologies, aligned with the needs of the Fourth Industrial Revolution.

Implemented under the Strategic Industry Partnership Program in TVET System (SIPTVETS) and supported by the Asian Development Bank, the center will serve as a hub for collaboration among government, industry, and academic institutions. It will also support higher-level certifications and diploma programs to enhance workforce competitiveness.

In parallel, TESDA is strengthening sustainability initiatives through a dedicated solar photovoltaic training facility and the installation of a 40-kilowatt solar system. These efforts aim to equip Filipinos with future-ready and green skills while promoting innovation, entrepreneurship, and inclusive growth.

ACTIONABLE ADVICE

Companies should align workforce development and hiring strategies with emerging skills in automation, digital technologies, and green energy. Businesses may also explore partnerships with TESDA for training, certification, and talent pipelines.
