SUMMARY

Pursuant to the policy of the State to protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology, and to promote transparency, accountability, and efficient public service delivery, the Order implements the Revised Price Monitoring System (RPMS) for forest products to streamline the generation of reliable and up-to-date price data and statistics of forest products for the information and guidance of the public.

The Order covers selected forest products such as logs, lumber, plywood, plyboard, firewood, charcoal, nipa shingles, sawali, rattan, bamboo, almaciga resin, beeswax, gutta-percha, anahaw leaves, poles, buri leaves/buri midribs, hingiw, honey, nipa sap, nito, and salago bark.

The Mobile Price Monitoring Application (MPMA), including its instruction manual, was adopted to improve the collection, consolidation, and analysis of price data and facilitate the timely and accurate collection, submission, and generation of reports.

Please see the Order for the rules and regulations on the implementation of the RPMS, as well as the user's manual for the MPMA.

ACTIONABLE ADVICE

Producers or sellers of forest products shall review the price bulletin of forest products every quarter, to serve as reference for the determination of fair prices of forest products. In addition, all proponents for government projects which shall use any of the aforementioned forest products shall ensure alignment with the prices as listed in the MPMA.
